Emmanuel Hospital Associations, (EHA)

EHA is a fellowship of Christian individuals and institutions committed to the ministry of healing in the name and spirit of Lord Jesus Christ since 1969. Today, EHA manages 19 hospitals, 26 community health projects, and 6 nursing schools and a college in India.

Herbertpur Christian Hospital, (Lehmann Hospital)

Herbertpur Christian Hospital is located at the foothills of the Himalayas in the state of Uttarakhand, in the northern region of India, bordering the neighboring states of Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, and Haryana. It is situated adjacent to two national highways—one connecting to New Delhi and the other leading to the state of Punjab. The hospital also lies on the main route linking the entire population of the mountainous Himalayan region of Chakrata to the plains. Its proximity to the state capital, Dehradun, enables us to regularly engage with the government on various health-related issues.

History

It is a unit of EHA, New Delhi, established in 1936 by Dr. Geoffrey Lehmann and Mrs. Monica Lehmann. The hospital was handed over to EHA in 1973. It has been serving the needy people of Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, and Uttar Pradesh for over 80 years.



Present

Herbertpur Christian Hospital is a 150 bedded multispecialty NABH accredited institution. It serves approximately 1.1 lakh outpatients annually. It is staffed with over 20 doctors, 90 nurses, 20 Paramedical staff and admits over 14,000 in - patients each year. The hospital has various departments, namely: Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, ENT, Dermatology, Anesthesiology, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, Dentistry, Psychiatry, 24-hour Emergency, Blood Bank, Ultrasonography, Radiography, Renal Dialysis, Palliative Care, Physiotherapy, Occupational therapy, Audiology & Speech therapy, Respiratory medicine, critical care services, Prosthetics & Orthotics, Carpentry and Community Health.

The Creation and the Evolution of the College of Nursing

The School of Nursing was built from scratch in 2013 on the foundation of a dream, vision, and several needs. Started with 20 students, but then the numbers were enhanced to 30 seats. The students who walked into these corridors to be trained as GNM nurses trailed and toiled but flew out in a wisp of pride and full of color. We have seen 13 batches of general nursing and midwifery students join and 9 batches have completed successfully. We always adhered to the Indian Nursing Council standards,

prioritizing quality and holistic excellence in nurturing students on these premises. Divine providence endowed this place with the blessing of upgrading to a college of nursing in 2024. 20 seats have been allotted for B.Sc. Nursing students and 30 seats for GNM students. Patient-centered care and ethical values are imbibed into the assignments and every curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular activity focused on holistic growth. Problems encountered have been catered to by counselling, mentoring, coaching, and parental involvement whenever necessary. The college is looking forward to establishing itself as a centre of training excellence in the state slowly but steadily.



Course Particulars

The Classes will begin in the first week of August 2026 (or as per notification of State nursing council and HNBU). During the training, the students will be taught to work in different sections of clinical facilities. These include wards, OPD, acute care settings like ICU, Labour Room and Community.

Health Care

All students are expected to be fully immunized with routine childhood vaccinations before starting the course. Once selected, the students will undergo a medical checkup. Fitness certificate will be issued by the Medical Director of Herbertpur Christian Hospital.

The students of Uttarakhand are required to have an active Ayushman Card on admission.

Course Outcome

At the end of the course, the GNM and B.Sc. Nurse will be able to function as a general practice nurse to provide comprehensive care / supervise and train nursing students at various health care settings and educational institutions and adhere to the code of Nursing Ethics.

Application Procedure:

1. The Application Form and Prospectus can be downloaded from the website <https://hch-eha.in> or <https://eha-health.org> from 1st April 2026.
2. Payment for the application is **Rs.900/- for B.Sc.** and **Rs.750/- for GNM.** It can be done by

3. Any correspondence (queries, bills, filled forms, etc.) regarding the admissions can be sent to hchconadmissions@gmail.com
4. Candidates are expected to read and understood the eligibility requirements &

admission Process.

5. It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility requirements for the course(s) applied.
6. The statutory body is the final authority to admit or reject the candidate.
7. If it is found at a later stage, during active verification, that the candidate has given false information / qualification obtained from unrecognized Board / University or is found to have concealed some information regarding eligibility or deliberately delayed submission of marks / grade sheets in spite of multiple reminders, her admission will be cancelled without any notice and the paid fee will be forfeited.
8. Self-attested copies of following credentials should be attached along with the application.
 - a. Transfer Certificate,

It is informed that as per the University Grants Commission (UGC) Notification dated 4th April, 2025 regarding UGC (Recognition and Grant of Equivalence to Qualifications obtained from Foreign Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2025 it is now University Grants Commission (UGC) and not Association of Indian Universities (AIU) which recognizes foreign academic qualifications and grant equivalence to such qualifications at both school and higher education levels as deemed necessary. It is therefore, the admission terms and conditions for foreign nationals seeking admission to GNM and B.Sc.(N) courses as mentioned in the revised B.Sc.(N) and GNM Syllabi are amended herewith.

Now, henceforth, **equivalency to foreign academic qualifications (Class XII) (entry level) for foreign nationals seeking admission to GNM and B.Sc.(N) programs shall be obtained from the UGC (link: <https://equivalence.ugc.ac.in/> also refer to UGC equivalence FAQs for the admission portal link: <https://equivalence.ugc.ac.in/Home/faq>) and not AIU.** This is mandatory for the foreign students seeking admission to GNM/B.Sc(N) programs. This issues with the approval of competent authority.

- b. Conduct certificate from the previous educational institution,
 - c. Mark list of the qualifying examination,
 - d. Aadhaar card and Ayushman card
9. Foreign Nationals: (as per the INC notification, kindly follow the given instructions.)

Eligibility

1. The minimum age limit for admission should be 17 years on 31st December 2026.
The maximum age limit for admission will be 35 years.
2. Minimum Educational Qualification
 - a. Pass in 12th Standard examination (10+2) with Science and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together.
 - b. Must have scored 40% marks in English.
3. Only **female** candidates need to apply
4. Applicants must be medically fit.
5. Eligible candidates are privileged to apply for both courses separately.

Allotment of Admissions

As per State and Central Govt. norms and conditions, 50% of seats will be filled as per the Government order. The remaining will be filled by the Management.

Method of Selection -For GNM

1. An Entrance test will be conducted, and it shall comprise of:

- Aptitude for Nursing 20 marks
 - Written Exam – 50 marks
 - General Knowledge 10 marks
 - General Subjects 10 marks
 - Health Related Knowledge 10 marks
 - English 10 marks
 - Math 10 marks
2. The minimum qualifying criteria for the entrance test are 50%.
 3. Qualifying candidates will be interviewed by the Selection Committee. The decision of the Selection Committee will be final.
 4. *The selected students are expected to pay the First year pay on the day of registration.*

Method of Selection - For B.Sc. Nursing

A. INSTITUTIONAL ENTRANCE EXAM

1. An Entrance test will be conducted, and it shall comprise of:
 - Aptitude for Nursing 20 marks
 - Written Exam – 50 marks
 - General Knowledge 05 marks
 - Physics, Chemistry, Biology 25 marks
 - English 10 marks
 - Math 10 marks

2. The minimum qualifying criteria for the entrance test are 50%.
3. Qualifying candidates will be interviewed by the Selection Committee.
4. The decision of the Selection Committee will be final.
5. *The selected students are expected to pay the First year pay on the day of registration.*

B. ADDITIONAL EXAMINATION for B.Sc Nursing Students

6. Entrance test shall be conducted by University/State Government (Association of Private Paramedical & Nursing Institutions - Uttarakhand).
7. Minimum 50% marks are necessary to qualify the State APPNI exam.

General Rules and Regulation

1. The students are expected to obey the rules and regulations of the College of Nursing, Herbertpur Christian Hospital and the Hostel.
2. Students must be willing to carry out any work allotted to them in the department as part of their learning process.
3. Hostel accommodation is provided for all students and staying in the hostels is mandatory.
4. Students should keep up regular attendance to enroll for examinations.
5. Students are not allowed to get married during the period of study.
6. All students are expected to complete the course without fail. In case anyone discontinues the course, he/she is liable to pay the full tuition fees for remaining years.
7. Disobedience, dishonesty, indifference, negligence etc. will be sternly dealt with.
8. Uniform will be compulsory.
9. At the time of admission, parents/guardians must give a list of visitors they would allow their wards to meet.
10. Students are encouraged to participate in campus activities.
11. Any documents required from the college office during study, the students must pay Rs. 400 to acquire it.
12. The students need to wear white attire during freshers' period.
13. Ragging is prohibited. Any student participating in ragging will be dismissed.

Leave Rules

- a. 30 days of annual leave and 10 days of sick leave per year.
- b. No leave is allowed for any family functions like birthdays, housewarming, anniversaries, baby

showers, etc.

- c. Only emergency leave for illness or death of any immediate significant other.
- d. Parents should write an email atleast 48 hours before for permission and allowing permit for their respective wards – hchoolofnursing@gmail.com
- e. No WhatsApp or Calls are entertained except for emergency cases.

Ragging

Ragging is not acceptable behavior in the campus of the Herbertpur Christian Hospital, College of Nursing. It is illegal according to Law to commit, participate in, a bet or propagate “ragging”. The institution will deal firmly and strictly with all instances of ragging. If any incidents of ragging come to the notice of the authorities, the student concerned will be given opportunity to explain. If the explanation is not satisfactory, the authorities will expel the student from the College of Nursing, Herbertpur Christian Hospital.

Possession Of Illicit Drugs, Alcohol And Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in the campuses of Herbertpur Christian Hospital.

Students are strictly NOT allowed to smoke in the college, hospital or hostel campus. If caught smoking or any smoking material is found in possession of the student, termination will proceed without any other consideration. The College management will NOT be responsible.

Students should not **consume or serve alcohol** on any occasion within the campus of HCH. Forcing a fellow student to consume alcohol would be grounds for severe disciplinary action.

The Indian Penal Code classifies obtaining, keeping or passing on banned drugs (such as marijuana, cocaine, heroin, etc.) as a criminal offence. Possession or use of banned drugs will result in expulsion from the HCH.

Involvement In Strikes And Criminal Acts

It is an illegal act to be involved in strike within the organization. In case, if the student is involved in this act, she may be liable for expulsion from the institution.

Miscellaneous

Any other activities which are likely to affect the peace and tranquility of the institution involvement in any sort of violence or disturbance both within and outside the institution / any criminal acts / offence as defined in the Indian Penal Code 1860 will result in expulsion from the Institution.
